In our whole life, in all our work and activity, we dwell in what has come from you, and we rejoice in Christ our Savior. Amen.

## IMPORTANT Finance Update – May 2017

As we approach the summer season, where attendance during Sunday worship usually declines, along with weekly giving, the Finance Committee felt we should share the state of our finances. We met on April 24<sup>th</sup> to discuss, again, the difficult financial situation our church is facing. While we have tried different soft approaches, the time is right to share the 'cold-hard truth.' There are several things you need to be aware of--Most importantly, at present, we anticipate between a 20 thousand and 30 thousand short-fall for this fiscal year. We are living, as they say, hand-to-mouth, week to week, paycheck to paycheck. If things do not change in the next couple of months, when summer arrives and our giving weakens further (as we all turn our minds to vacations), we will not have enough funds to meet our monthly obligations. The Finance Committee has made a list of the hard choices that may have to be considered; things like cutting our worship music program, reducing the hours of church office staff, and going to a part time pastor (would possibly mean a new pastor). Whether we were to be forced to make one of these choices or all of them, there would surely be a negative impact on our church.

On the positive side, there are promising items that are being established and worked on to help offset the projected deficit, like formation of the Fundraising Team and increased advertising for Tabor Treasures. While these items are blooming and give us hope, no one item is going to solve the current financial situation; which is why we decided it is time to put the cold-hard facts in front of you, the members.

We know that this is not something that one person or committee can solve alone; but as a church, we can; and I hope and pray we will find the inner strength to overcome. Some may be thinking, 'I made the effort the last time,' or 'maybe everyone else will step up,' which is fine until only a few do or no one does, at which time we will have to go to the list of hard choices and start making cuts.

For reference, our monthly expenses average 10 thousand a month. Plate giving has been averaging about 1500 a week, or 6 thousand a month. Rental donations and Tabor Treasures income are averaging around 2 thousand per month. We come up short by a couple thousand every month that has 4 Sundays, and almost break even when we have a 5 Sunday month. Broken down to a weekly number, we need to increase the amount coming in, or decrease our expenses going out, by \$550 to \$850 EACH WEEK.

Our goal as a church should be to fund missions. Currently, our only planned mission giving is to the benevolences of the UMC Conference, which we have been forced to put on hold due to the financial situation (We had pledged to give at least 10% of our monthly income). Together, as a congregation, we need to resolve to rise up to first stabilize our church, and then fund missions that are important to us and Jesus Christ.

There are several ways you can participate—through one time giving; an increase in weekly giving; and/or giving on weeks you do not attend worship services. Consider joining the Fundraising Team, leading the Team, contribute to fundraisers, or create a fundraiser of your own (please run any ideas by Pastor Amanda first). Volunteer to research Stewardship ideas. Invite friends, family, and co-workers to church—The more our membership grows, the less our financial worries will be.

We ask that you take a moment and ask God for guidance, look deep inside, and act. It is through action and grace that we will overcome this difficult situation.

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
# TRUSTEES CORNER!


