We are entering the Lenten Season – a forty-day celebration before the Easter celebration.

TIPS ON STAYING TRUE TO LENTEN SACRIFICES

Keep a crucifix nearby. A glance at the cross can remind you of the sacrifice the Lord made for us. It also demonstrates His great love for us. Perhaps you can keep a cross in your pocket during the Lenten season. When you feel tempted to break from your sacrifices, you can clutch the cross in the hope of being given the strength you need.

Have a traveling companion during Lent who can help keep you accountable. This could be a spiritual director, confessor, spouse, friend or fellow congregant. They can serve as a coach to you and you can do the same for them.

A pair of shoes can convey a special poignancy. Jesus says, "Follow me." We are to follow Him and walk in His footprints which inevitably take us to Calvary. Our faith tells us, though, that there is more to the story—the glory of the resurrection.

Lent, with all of its introspection and solitude, is a great time to journal. When you write something down it can be so revealing. Journaling through Lent can help you hold true to your Lenten sacrifices. Writing is not only therapeutic but it also makes us accountable..

Reach out to others in need. Give undivided attention to a friend, family member or someone in need of solace. If you can, dip into your pocket to assist someone in need of food or funds to make it through a crisis.

Daily Lent Devotionals 2022



Wednesday 03/02/2022 - Ash Wednesday – Joel 2:12 “Yet even now, says the LORD, return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning.”

Prayer: Righteous God, in humility and repentance we bring our failures in caring, helping, and loving, we bring the pain we have caused other, we bring the injustice in society of which we are a part, to the transforming power of your grace.

Thursday 03/03/2022 – Joel 2:13 “rend your hearts and not your clothing. Return to the LORD, your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love, and relents from punishing.”

Prayer: Grant us the courage to accept the healing you offer and to turn again toward the sunrise of your reign, that we may walk with you in the promise of peace you have willed for all the children of the earth, and have made known to us in Christ Jesus. Amen.

Friday 03/04/2022 – Isaiah: 58:3 "Why do we fast, but you do not see? Why humble ourselves, but you do not notice?" Look, you serve your own interest on your fast day, and oppress all your workers.”

Prayer: O God, you delight ... in a humble and contrite heart. Overturn our love of worldly possessions and fix our hearts more firmly on you, that, having nothing, we may yet possess everything, a treasure stored up for us in heaven.

Saturday 03/05/2022- Psalm 51:1- “Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions.”

Prayer: Look with mercy on our contrite hearts ... and create a new and right spirit in us, that we may declare your praise and offer an acceptable sacrifice in these Lenten days; through Christ Jesus, who bore our sins on the cross.

Sunday 03/06/2022 - Luke 4:1 - Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness

Prayer: God of wilderness and water, your Son was baptized and tempted as we are. Guide us through this season, that we may not avoid struggle, but open ourselves to blessing, through the cleansing depths of repentance and the heaven-rending words of the Spirit.

Monday 03/07/2022 – Psalm 91:14 -15 – “Those who love me, I will deliver; I will protect those who know my name. When they call to me, I will answer them; I will be with them in trouble, I will rescue them and honor them.”

Prayer: Help us as we take up your invitation to prayer and simplicity, that the discipline of these forty days may sharpen our hunger for the feast of your holy friendship and whet our thirst for the living water you offer through Jesus Christ.

Tuesday 03/08/2022- Romans 10:12 - For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; the same Lord is Lord of all and is generous to all who call on him.

Prayer: Beloved friends, in this season of repentance and healing, we accept God's invitation to be ever mindful of the needs of others, offering our prayers on behalf of God's community in the church and the world.


Wednesday 03/09/2022 – Psalm 91:9 -11 - Because you have made the LORD your refuge, the Most High your dwelling place, no evil shall befall you, no scourge come near your tent. For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.

Prayer: Fill us with your strength to resist the seductions of our foolish desires and the tempter's vain delights, that we may walk in obedience and righteousness, rejoicing in you with an upright heart.

Thursday 03/10/2022 - Romans 10:13 For, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

Prayer: In this time of repentance, draw all people to yourself...

that Jesus Christ is Lord, now and for ever. Amen.



Friday 03/11/2022 - Deuteronomy 26:10-11 - So now I bring the first of the fruit of the ground that you, O LORD, have given me." You shall set it down before the LORD your God and bow down before the LORD your God. Then you, together with the Levites and the aliens who reside among you, shall celebrate with all the bounty that the LORD your God has given to you and to your house.

Prayer: God of deliverance and freedom, you taught the people of Israel to acknowledge that all things come from your bountiful hand.

Saturday 03/12/2022 - Romans 10:9-10 because if you confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For one believes with the heart and so is justified, and one confesses with the mouth and so is saved.

Prayer: Deepen our faith so that we may resist temptation and, in the midst of trial, proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord, now and for ever. Amen.

Sunday 03/13/2022 Genesis 15:5 He brought him outside and said, "Look toward heaven and count the stars, if you are able to count them." Then he said to him, "So shall your descendants be."

Prayer: Hope beyond all human hope, you promised descendants as numerous as the stars to old Abraham and barren Sarah.

Monday 03/14/2022 – Psalm 27:14 Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the LORD!

Prayer: Grant, O God, that the prayers we offer may be your channel for new and abundant life not only hoped for, but worked for, through faithful word and deed.

Tuesday 03/15/2022 Psalm 27:8 "Come," my heart says, "seek his face!" Your face, LORD, do I seek.

Prayer: We lay before you the desires of our hearts, that we may be transformed by their fulfillment.



Wednesday 03/16/2022 Psalm 27:7 Hear, O LORD, when I cry aloud, be gracious to me and answer me

Prayer: Whet our thirst for the living water you offer through Jesus Christ.

Thursday 03/17/2022 Psalm 27:14 Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the LORD!

Prayer: Grant, O God, that the prayers we offer may be your channel for new and abundant life not only hoped for, but worked for, through faithful word and deed.

Friday 03/18/2022 – Psalm 27:1 The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Prayer: You promise light and salvation in the midst of darkness and despair, and promise redemption to a world that will not listen.

Saturday 03/19/2022 Luke 13:34b *“How often have I desired to gather your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you were not willing!”*

Prayer: Gather us to yourself in tenderness, open our ears to listen to your word, and teach us to live faithfully as people confident of the fulfillment of your promises.

Sunday 03/20/2022 Isaiah 55:8-9 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Prayer: Artist of souls, you sculpted a people for yourself out of the rocks of wilderness and fasting.

Monday 03/21/2022 Psalm 63:1 O God, you are my God, I seek you, my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water.

Prayer: Help us as we take up your invitation to prayer and simplicity, that the discipline of these forty days may sharpen our hunger for the feast of your holy friendship, Help us



Tuesday 03/22/2022 1 Corinthians 10:4 and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual rock that followed them, and the rock was Christ.

Prayer: ...and whet our thirst for the living water you offer through Jesus Christ.

Wednesday 03/23/2022 55:6-7 Seek the LORD while he may be found, call upon him while he is near; let the wicked forsake their way, and the unrighteous their thoughts; let them return to the LORD, that he may have mercy on them, and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

Prayer: Faithful God of love, you blessed us with your servant Son so that we might know how to serve your people with justice and with mercy

Thursday 03/24/2022 10:13 No testing has overtaken you that is not common to everyone. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tested beyond your strength, but with the testing he will also provide the way out so that you may be able to endure it.

Prayer: We gather the needs of ourselves and others, and offer them to you in faith and love, seeking to be strengthened to meet them.

Friday 03/25/2022 Psalm 63:7 For you have been my help, and in the shadow of your wings I sing for joy. My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me.

Prayer: God of infinite goodness, throughout the ages you have persevered in claiming and reclaiming your people.

Saturday 03/26/2022 10:13 No testing has overtaken you that is not common to everyone. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tested beyond your strength, but with the testing he will also provide the way out so that you may be able to endure it.

Prayer: Renew for us your call to repentance, surround us with witnesses to aid us in our journey, and grant us the time to fashion our lives anew, through Jesus Christ our Savior. Amen.

Sunday 03/27/2022 2 Corinthians 5:18-20 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation; 5:19 that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us. So we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us; we entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

Prayer: God of the covenant, in the glory of the cross your Son embraced the power of death and broke its hold over your people. In this time of repentance, draw all people to yourself.

Monday 03/28/2022 Psalm 32:5 Then I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not hide my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," and you forgave the guilt of my sin.

Prayer: You open your arms to accept us even before we turn to meet your welcome; you invite us to forgiveness even before our hearts are softened to repentance.

Tuesday 03/29/2022 - Luke 15:18-20 I will get up and go to my father, and I will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son; treat me like one of your hired hands." So he set off and went to his father. But while he was still far off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion; he ran and put his arms around him and kissed him.

Prayer: God of patient love, you await the return of the wayward and wandering and eagerly embrace them in pardon.

Wednesday 03/30/2022 2 Corinthians 5:17 So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new!

Prayer: Through baptism you have clothed us with the glory of Christ and restored our inheritance.

Thursday 03/31/2022 Luke 5:22 But the father said to his slaves, 'Quickly, bring out a robe--the best one--and put it on him; put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. And get the fatted calf and kill it, and let us eat and celebrate; for this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found!' And they began to celebrate.

Prayer: give us generous hearts to welcome all who seek a place at the table of your unconditional love.

Friday 04/01/2022 Psalm 32:6 Therefore let all who are faithful offer prayer to you; at a time of distress, the rush of mighty waters shall not reach them.

Prayer: Eternal lover of our wayward..., we praise you for your ever-open door.




